Note: You may mail your application and payment (check or paypal Transaction ID) to Seminole Pool and Tennis Association, 2935 S. Fish Hatchery Rd., PMB 177, Madison, WI 53711 or you may hand deliver to The UPS Store at Yarmouth Crossing (corner of S. Fish Hatchery Rd and PD) in an envelope marked "Seminole Pool". We must receive your initiation fee to reserve your spot at the pool. Annual dues are due by April 14, 2010. If you join the pool after April 14, please include both your initiation fee and your annual dues along with your application.

Seasonal Membership Policy: If you become a seasonal member this year we encourage you to join Seminole Pool and Tennis Association as a Permanent Member for the 2011 season at which time your \$115.00 2010 Seasonal Initiation Fee will be applied toward your Permanent Initiation Fee (\$550.00 for the 2010 Season). If you do not become a Permanent Member in 2011, your Seasonal Initiation Fee is forfeited.

Pool Packets: Each year the pool produces a packet containing information about the various activities at the pool, including the calendar, swim and tennis lesson registration, swim and dive team information and tennis league information. These packets will be available at www.seminolepool.org in late April. Hard copies will be available at the poolhouse.

Address changes: All members are responsible for notifying the Seminole Pool of any address and/or telephone change.

Open House: The pool's Open House is scheduled for Saturday, May 15, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. At the Open House, you may register for swim lessons, swim and dive teams, and tennis lessons and leagues. Payment for swim and dive team and tennis is required at sign-up. If you are unable to attend the Open House, you may register for available activities after the pool opens May 29, 2010.

Tennis Court Key: The tennis courts are kept locked at all times. Keys are available at the pool registration desk during pool hours or please contact our Tennis representative (Mike Martin, e-mail: tennis@seminolepool.org) to be issued a key. A deposit is required.

Cancellations: To cancel your permanent membership, the Seminole Pool must receive written notification by April 14th. You may either mail or hand-deliver it to The UPS Store (address noted above). According to our by-laws, the Corporation shall keep a list of all members wishing to withdraw their memberships. Memberships shall be transferred to new members from the list of withdrawing members in chronological order. Return of the Initiation Fee shall be made upon the Board securing a transfer of membership. If you do not terminate your membership by April 14, you will be responsible for the annual dues for that year and a late fee, if applicable. Members who cancel their membership by April 14 will receive their Initiation Fee, less sales tax, once the board has secured a transfer of membership. Membership Records will acknowledge the receipt of your cancellation letter with a postcard.
